



URBAN FORESTRY BY CERTIFIED ARBORISTS

Upland and Wetland Communities:

- Inventory and evaluate ecological signs of protected plant and tree species
- Identify space requirements for preserving the integrity of natural plant communities for site plans
- Develop specifications for controlling invasive species and enhancing the diversity and function of native plant associations for agency permits
- Devise plant restoration and mitigation plans inclusive of site preparation, plant selection, planting and establishment practices
- Appraisal of tree and landscaping values



- Local government tree management plan designs and specifications
- Site planning for habitat protection and sustainable urban and rural landscapes
- Scouting for Listed Plant Species
- Diagnostic and remedial tree services
- Grand tree measurement and condition evaluations
- Coordinate wetland/upland tree removal, bracing, restorative cuts, fertilization and aeration beds

- Coordinate and monitor root pruning procedures, organic and biological soil amendments and ANSI A300 pruning techniques
- Permitting and supervision of all pruning operations including mangroves by ISA Certified Arborist to ensure compliance with Best Management Practices (BMP) and regulatory requirements
